



**NOTICE OF 30-DAY PERIOD
FOR PUBLIC COMMENT**

Preliminary Findings Regarding a Minor Source Operating Permit

For Kyger Bakery Products, Inc. in Marion County

Permit No.: M097-25734-00637

Indianapolis Office of Environmental Services (OES) and Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) have received an application from Kyger Baker Products, Inc. located at 7575 Georgetown Road, for a Minor Source Operating Permit (MSOP). IDEM's Office of Air Quality (OAQ) and OES issue this type of permit to regulate construction and operation of new sources, and modifications at existing sources that release air pollutants.

OES has reviewed this application, and has developed preliminary findings, consisting of a draft permit and several associated documents, that would allow Kyger Baker Products, Inc. to construct and operate a bakery. If this would operate 365 days a year, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, it could potentially release 2.06 tons of PM / PM-10, 0.11 tons of sulfur dioxide, 26.16 tons of VOC, 15.37 tons of carbon monoxide, 18.84 tons of nitrogen oxides, 0.74 tons of single HAP and 1.10 tons of combined HAPs, per year.

How can you participate in this process?

The day after this announcement is published in a newspaper marks the beginning of a 30-day public comment period. During that 30-day period, you may comment on this draft permit. If the 30th day of the comment period falls on a day when IDEM or OES offices are closed for business, all comments must be postmarked or delivered in person on the next business day that IDEM or OES is open.

You may request that OES hold a public hearing about this draft permit. If adverse comments concerning the **air pollution impact** of this draft permit are received, with a request for a public hearing, OES may hold a public hearing. If a public hearing is held, OES will make a separate announcement of the date, time, and location of that hearing. At a hearing, you would have an opportunity to submit written comments, make verbal comments, ask questions, and discuss any air pollution concerns with OES staff.

Comments and supporting documentation or a request for a public hearing should be sent in writing to OES. If you do not want to comment at this time, but would like to be added to the OES mailing list to receive notice of future action related to this permit application, please contact OES. All comments will be considered by OES and IDEM when we make a decision to issue or deny the permit. Comments that are most likely to affect final permit decisions are those based on the rules and laws governing this permitting process (326 IAC 2), air quality issues, and technical issues. IDEM and OES do not have legal authority to regulate zoning, odor or noise. For such issues, please contact appropriate City of Indianapolis and Marion County offices.

What will happen after IDEM and OES make a decision?

Following the end of the public comment period, OES and IDEM will issue a Notice of Decision stating whether the permit has been issued or denied. If the permit is issued, it may be different than the draft permit because of comments that were received during the public comment period. If comments are received during the public notice period, the final decision will include a document that summarizes the comments and OES response to those comments. If you have submitted comments or have asked to be added to the mailing list, you will receive a Notice of the Decision. The notice will provide details on how you may appeal OES decision, if you disagree with that decision. The final decision will also be available on the Internet at the address indicated above, at the local library indicated above, at the OES, 2700 South Belmont Avenue, Indianapolis, 46221, and IDEM public file room on the 12th floor of the Indiana Government Center North, 100 N. Senate, Indianapolis, IN 46204.
